

Cast Member Costumes:

Generally, cast members will wear the same costumes. What will decipher the various roles the cast members are playing will be the information on their name tag. This allows cast members to play various roles throughout the day and not look out of place. The only thing they would have to change is their name tag. The costume will consist of a rash guard (available in various colors), board shorts and comfortable walking shoes (stipend and permissible style shoe to be determined by the company). Several costumes will be issued to the cast members upon hiring. Care of these costumes will be the responsibility of the cast member; however, the company will replace any worn out costumes at no additional cost to the cast members. Replacement for lost, stolen or unmanaged costumes will be the responsibility of the cast members. Back-stage cast members will wear different costumes. Managers/supervisors will wear collared shirts and nice slacks. Maintenance will wear dark blue pants (optional denim) and long sleeve shirts.

Various Roles:

The name tag will tell the guest what the role of the cast member is. There will be on-stage cast members as well as back-stage cast members.

Cook: Works in the Tidal Zone Café on counter or as a cook

Crew: Works on the attractions, within the queue, operation and the desk at the entrance

Deck Hand: Custodial department

Chief Mate: Manager

Helmsman: Security

Custodial 3

Café 3

Attractions 9

Security 2

Dive Shop 2

Maintenance 2

Manager 1

Manager, Security, and Maintenance will be the only jobs that will not be cross trained. At time more people can be scheduled as needed and some of the shifts may overlap during certain times of the day.
